Scrapbook Club

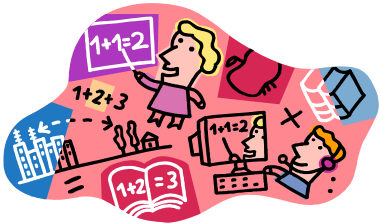

GM Shulamn is currently ranked 16th in the world and the students will split their time between supervised play and group instruction . There will be tournaments and team activities as well as learning about the history and geography of chess. Each week, a different child will be asked to research and present information regarding a grandmaster. This is designed to develop public speaking and leadership skills. Parents are welcome to come and learn with their child at any time and a tuition discount is available for any student whose parent volunteers to help with the entire session. **For Grades 2-8.** (1st grade students already enrolled in Fall session may re-enroll)
