Eligibility - Priority Groups for the H1N1 Vaccine

- ▶ pregnant women
- ▶ persons who live with or provide care for infants aged <6 months (e.g., parents, siblings, and daycare providers)
- ▶ health-care and emergency medical services personnel
- ▶ persons aged 6 months--24 years
- ▶ persons aged 25--64 years who have medical conditions that put them at higher risk for influenza-related complications
